
Our goal is to improve our knowledge of Jesus, God and the Bible in regards to living in today's world.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16 - NOVEMBER 16 | 2 P.M.


Do you ever feel like a second-class citizen in this world? Do you wonder how God could possibly use you to change lives?



Join this group on Wednesday evenings for a six-week Bible study, "Be the Bridge: Pursuing God's Heart for Racial Reconciliation," by Latasha Morrison, to examine how we, as children of God, can participate in biblical racial reconciliation. This study will examine the historical complexities of racism and expertly apply biblical principles, such as lamentation, confession, and forgiveness, to lay the framework for restoration with conviction and grace. The book with the same title will be a required text.
